In his letter to me of 23 March Mr. MacGregor refers to his memorandum of 27 February to the Distington Joint Representative Committee: this was one of the documents which you sent me following our meeting on 4 March. It seems to me that Mr. MacGregor has, in this memorandum, given a very full and considered explanation of the reasons which led the Corporation to decide on the closure of Distington foundry. I would be grateful if you would treat this letter, together with my letter of 26 March, as a reply to the large number of letters from your constituents on the closure of Distington foundry which you have forwarded to me in recent weeks.
