Ami Mont Prime Minister CPRS NATIONALISED INDUSTRIES STUDY Kenneth Clarke will represent me at your meeting next Tuesday to consider the report. I have now read it, and discussed its main conclusions with Mr Ibbs. I agree with the analysis and the central recommendations of the CPRS study. Clearly detailed work has now to be done; and this must recognise the different circumstances of different industries and therefore the different relationships with Government. But fast progress along the lines which Mr Ibbs indicates will pay dividends.
