These are:-

1. Future Party Policy

Can you consider a re-statement - perhaps in a major speech - of what we want to achieve in the Conservative Party in this Parliament?

2. The Future of the Labour Party

Sir Paul Bryan, in particular, would like to have your views on the prospects for the Labour Party in the light of its present leadership and policy commitments.

3. Anglo-American Relations

The Executive would like your later feelings on these relations.

4. Europe and the Lebanon

Edward du Cann would like you to say a few words about the Athens Summit and MNF. He said that a repeat of the admirable confidential briefing you gave at the Unionist Club dinner on Wednesday night would perfectly fit the bill.
