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B. INGHAM 13 January 1983 BRIEF ON FLIGHT NO 4783 FROM ASCENSION ISLAND TO PORT STANLEY ON 8 JANUARY 1983

Aircraft

1. A Hercules PLR2 will operate from Ascension Island to Port Stanley on 8 January 1983.

Crew

2. The crew from No 47 Sqn, RAF Lyneham is as follows:

Route

3. The route is the standard airbridge route which is direct to Port Stanley. The distance is 3,383 nms, and the flight time will be about 13 hrs 30 mins.

Air to Air Refuelling

4. Three air to air refuelling rendezvous are planned as follows:

 $\frac{RV1}{Hercules}$ At $4\frac{1}{2}$ hrs/1150 nms into the flight the Hercules PLR2 will be refuelled by Hercules C130K Mk 1 when 25,000 lbs of fuel will be transferred.

RV2 At 1200 nms a Victor K Mk2 will replenish the Hercules C130 Tanker with 50,000 lbs of fuel the Victor will then return to Ascension.

<u>RV3</u> At $9\frac{1}{2}$ hrs/2450 nms the replenished Hercules Tanker will transfer 30,000 lbs more fuel. It will then return to Ascension.

Overhead Port Stanley

5. The aircraft will arrive overhead Port Stanley with some 57,000 lbs of fuel. This will be enough to return to Ascension Island in the unlikely event of being unable to land at Port Stanley.
