Dear Teddy,

Thank you for your letter of 18 April. I am grateful to you for drawing my attention to what seems to be an unsatisfactory state of affairs on the question of aerial advertising, and I sympathise with you and your constituents at the Airborne factory in Southend over the difficulties they currently face.

It is puzzling that the present situation should have gone on for so long. For that reason alone, I shall certainly look into the points you make, although clearly there are differences of emphasis on this question between the Departments of Trade and the Environment. I very much hope they will quickly resolve any difficulties. As soon as the picture becomes clearer I shall write to you again.
