Notes for Editors

The Queen has been pleased to approve that the dignity of a Barony of the United Kingdom for Life be conferred on Mr Hamish Gray, and that the honour of Knighthood be conferred on Mr Mayhew on his appointment as Solicitor-General.

As Minister for the Arts, Lord Gowrie will be responsible for an Office of Arts and Libraries, which will be attached to the Privy Council Office. A Transfer of Functions Order will be laid before Parliament.

The Prime Minister has also asked Lord Gowrie to assist her in her capacity as Minister for the Civil Service by discharging the day-to-day responsibilities for the functions now undertaken by the Management and Personnel Office, which will become part of the Cabinet Office.
