THE JOURNAL

Your interview will be the "In Depth" segment of this networked hour long news programme. The interviewer will be Barbara Frumm who is articulate, sometimes aggressive though no match for you, but certainly a stronger character than this morning's interviewer. She hopes to cover -

UK domestic situation - "Thatcherism"
NATO/INF/Defence
International economic situation/prospects
The Middle East and Northern Ireland

The interview will be filmed in the Governor General's suite just down the corridor from your suite. It will be transmitted about 2230 hours.

MACLEANS MAGAZINE

Canada's only weekly news magazine. It is of the "TIME" type. Editorially it takes a centre right position. The interviewer will be David North, an Englishman, whose personal views are somewhat to the left of the magazine's. He hopes to cover essentially the same ground as "The Journal" but in more depth. The interview will be in a sitting room just around the corner from the Governor General's suite.
