- 1. ROBERT FELLOWES (ASSISTANT PRIVATE SECRETARY AT BUCKINGHAM PALACE) CONTACTED SIR PAUL SCHOON GOVERNOR GENERAL OF GRENADA BY TELEPHONE AT 09002 THIS MORNING.
- 2. SCOON TOLD HIM THAT AUSTIN CHAIRMAN OF MILITARY COUNCIL
 CALLED ON HIM YESTERDAY TO CONFIRM THAT MILITARY COUNCIL IN
 CONTROL, BUT THAT WITHIN THREE DAYS HE INTENDED TO ANNOUNCE
 COMPOSITION OF BROADLY BASED CABINET REPRESENTING ALL WALKS OF
 LIPE. IN ANSWER TO DIRECT QUESTIONS AUSTIN SAID THAT HE DID
 NOT INTEND TO FILL ROLE OF PRIME MINISTER. MILITARY WOULD NOT B
 REPRESENTED IN CABINET. ASKED BY SCOON WHETHER INTENTION WAS
 TO RETURN TO CONSTITUTIONAL GOVERNMENT, AUSTIN REPLIED 'NOT AT
 THIS STAGE'.
- 3. SCOON URGED AUSTIN TO HOLD ENQUIRY INTO DEATHS OF BISHOP AND OTHERS. AUSTIN AGREED SAYING THAT 18 PROPLE HAD DIED. SCOON BELIEVES THE ACTUAL PIGURE TO BE MUCH HIGHER.
- N. AUSTIN SAID THAT HE WOULD BE GOING TO ST VINCENT TO MEET PRIME MINISTER CATO OVER THE WEEKEND (WE PRESUME AUSTIN'S AIM MUST BE TO HEAD OFF ANY INITIATIVE BY CARLCOM GOVERNMENTS CALLING FOR ACTION, MILITARY OR OTHERWISE AGAINST GRENADA)
- 5. GOVERNOR GENERAL ASSURED FELLOWES THAT THERE WAS NO THREAT TO HIMSELF OR TO LADY SCOON, AND THAT THEY WERE BOTH IN GOOD FORM. IT WAS EXPECTED THAT CURPEN WOULD BE LIFTED AT 0600 HOURS LOCAL TIME (10002) TOMORROW.
- 6. FOR WASHINGTON YOU MAY INFORM THE AMERICANS OF THE ABOVE IN STRICT CONFIDENCE EMPHASISING THE PRIVACY OF ANY CONTACTS
