MEMORANDUM

Topic: Mrs Thatcher’s visit to Hungary

Today Fortescue British councillor called me on telephone and enquired whether we had received information on the talk that had taken place between our ambassador and Bullard Deputy-Secretary of State on Friday, the 4<sup>th</sup> November. To my yes reply – as he said – for the sake of order he broadly *[original Hungarian expression "in big lines"]* repeated that was in the report sent by our ambassador. He referred to Thatcher’s speech planned for the 14<sup>th</sup> November and to the date’s approach *[original Hungarian "nearness"]* and asked for our prompt reply.

He also asked us to treat the prime minister’s intention to visit Hungary confidentially until, based on mutual decision, we do not make the information public.
