nothing else.

1978 - Jimmy Carter - 3 days on discussion
but no arms



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1978 - Jim Callaghan - went to W. Mexico.

No arms.

- Then raids on border began,
600 killed in first.

- Then China gave us arms.

To kill front men - like Christians
when my Xmas friends reported me.
But no sophisticated weapons

manufacture weapons.

Deterrents are not enough.

Have to find something in between
fear and anger.

i.e. increased security at lower levels of
armament.

Need tool or argument to
increase disarmament.

But key to security is
psychological disposition

Know other side - other influence
Then can make agreements

Zimbabwe - — Has had a struggle
to free itself from colonisation
~~To~~ have democracy.

- Int community condemned
~~the~~ int^l in Grenada.
- Commonwealth countries gave
cover to U.S.A for action
which violated int^l law.
- U.S. obeyed to Bishop's regime
other than those who were even
more leftist.
- More Cubans in U.S. than in
Grenada



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All accept that action has been
accompanied by some degree of legitimacy

But action will have given comfort
to S. Africa. Cuban Communists in
Angola. N. Korean Communists in
Zimbabwe. Communists in Zambia.

We criticized the U.S. on
Afghanistan, Vietnam or
Cambodia. So did O.E.C.S. - But

they with us today? What
about Nicaragua? By what

will we then try to manipulate us, if
they do not like our regime

What is more dangerous is ideological
race & competition



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What is dangerous is not U.S. USSR,
or British, are the smaller countries,
- the Cubans, the North Koreans -
others who profess themselves as innocents.
They could destabilise countries in the
region. We don't know what
Non-aligned is.

Developed competition that will
involve conflict.

Nigeria - Must hear other side of the
story.

Generally predict against intervention
but we decided to wait them down



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Own colleagues.

Not all democracies, not all communists
are we not all entitled to protect
our own way of life.

We are threatened by other systems,
- apartheid. Can't be protected ourselves
against it. - Military dictatorship

What happens if democracy is overthrown
by those systems

Let the democracies come & help us
against those - and help us to
protect our way of life.

Must have some direction - not
merely complain



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Commonwealth cherishes democracy &
should work towards its preservation.
Does that justify intervention?
Should direct our attention to
these issues
