Following our meeting at Cabinet this morning,
I have spoken to the D.P.P. who is going to take over
the case involving Mr Taylor who was forced off the
road and threatened. He is also ging to consider
those more serious cases which he could properly take
over. He is drawing to the attention of the County
prosecuting solicitors the need to apply for expedited
trial in appropriate cases and generally he will keep
a close eye on the situation. I shall also be discussing
with him cases which it might be necessary to move out
of Yorkshire for trial either at the Old Bailey or a
more friendly County.
