On 2/11/81, who has provided reliable information b7D in the past, advised that he had overheard two unknown males in the Boars Head Restaurant, Falls Church, Virginia, discussing what he believed might be a plot to assassinate Prime Minister Thatcher. Source had no apparent prior knowledge of Mrs. Thatcher's visit and has never expressed knowledge or interest in the politics of Northern Ireland.






