## FUTURE OF HONG KONG: CONVERSATION WITH NCNA

- 1. SHR S Y CHUNG AND Q W LEE CALLED ON ME ON 1 OCTOBER TO REPORT ON A DESCUSSION THEY HAD HAD THE PREVIOUS EVENING WHITH XU JUNTUM (NONA DERECTOR, AND CHINESE COMMUNIST PARTY CENTRAL COMMUNISTER MEMBER) AND LIE CHUWEN (AN NONA DEPUTY DERECTOR). THE MEETING WAS ARRANGED ON NONA WHITH ATTIVE AND AT SHORT NOTICE, NO DOUBT BECAUSE XU WHO ONLY ARRIVED BACK FROM PEKHING ON 29 SEPTEMBER AFTER SEVERAL WEEKS ABSENCE, WHISHED TO TALK TO SHR S Y CHUNG AND LEE BEFORE THEY LEFT FOR LONDON WHITH THE OTHER UNOFFICINALS.
- 2. THE CONVERSATION, WHICH WAS FRIENDLY AND LASTED OVER TWO HOURS RANGED WIDELY OVER THE CHINESE POSITION ON SOVEREIGNTY AND ADMINISTRATION, THE STATE OF THE HONG KONG ECONOMY AND THE DOLLAR ETC. SHR S Y AND LEE CLEARLY SPOKE WELL IN REBUTTING STANDARD CHINESE ARGUMENTS, AND HAN EXPLANATING THE COMPLEXATY OF HONG KONG, THE AMPORTANCE OF CONFIDENCE AND THE NEED FOR CONTINUENG ANSULATION.
- 3. THE MANN PONINTS OF HINTEREST WERE:-
- (1) XU WAS VERY FARM ON THE HANDALVASHABILITY OF SOVEREIGNTY AND ADMINISTRATION, ARGUMING THAT ONCE THIS PRINCIPLE WAS CONCEDED THE CHANESE WOULD BE FOUND TO BE VERY FLEXIBLE ON EVERYTHING ELSE. THE UNOFFICIALS TOLD HIM THAT HIT WAS NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR THE CHINESE TO HANSHIST THAT THEMR DEMANDS SHOULD BE MET BEFORE NEGOTIFICATIONS BEGAN.

(2) XU ASKED ABOUT THE MEANING OF THE QUOTE BRUTESH LINK UNQUOTE WHICH THE BRITISH WERE SEEKING TO MAINTAIN AFTER 1997. SIR S Y SAID THAT WAS A QUESTION FOR THE NEGOTIATIONS HAN PEKING, BUT TO HIS MIND INT MEANT EFFECTHIVE BRITTISH CONTROL.

(3) XU ALSO REFERRED TO THE QUESTINON OF LAND LEASES IN THE NEW TERRITORIES, AND SAND THAT HE ARRANGEMENTS COULD BE MADE FOR THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT TO SELL LAND FOR TERMS EXTENDING BEYOND 1997 THE SHITUATHON WOULD BE GREATLY HMPROVED. ON THIS SEE MAFT.

MUPT: FUTURE OF HONG KONG: CONVERSATION WITH NCNA

1. XU DECLINED TO ELABORATE ON WHAT HE HAD HIN MIND OVER INDIVIDUAL LAND LEASES AND HT HIS NOT CLEAR WHITH WHAT AUTHORITY HE SPOKE. HE MAY HAVE BEEN INFLUENCED BY HIS DISCUSSIONS WHITH THE HUNG YEE KUK WHO NEVER MISS AN OPPORTUNITY TO RAISE THE QUESTION OF LAND RIGHTS IN THE NEW TERRITORIES. THE PROPOSAL WHICH WE PUT FORWARD IN 1979 FOR ACTION TO ENABLE THE HONG KONG GOVERNMENT TO GRANT LEASES HIN THE NEW TERRITORIES EXTENDING BEYOND 1997 WAS FIRMLY REJECTED AT THE TIME, AND THERE HAVE BEEN NO OTHER HADDICATIONS THAT THE CHINESE HAVE BEEN RECONSIDERING THE QUESTION. AUTHORITATIVE CHINESE PUBLIC STATEMENTS OVER THE 1 OCTOBER HOLD DAY HAVE PUT FRESH EMPHASIS ON THE RECOVERY OF THE EXERCISE OF SOVERENGNTY. (PEKING TELNO 971).

2. SHR S Y HS AWARE OF THE BACKGROUND BUT HS HINCLINED TO HINTERPRET XU'S MENTHON OF LAND LEASES AS AN INDICATION THAT THE CHINESE MAY BE READY TO REACH A SHORT TERM ACCOMMODATION IN ORDER TO STABILLISE THE SHTUATION HERE, LEAVING A LONGER TERM SOLUTION TO BE PURSUED AT LEHSURE. HE TOLD SHR S Y THAT HE WAS DRAWING LARGE CONCLUSIONS ON FLISMY EVIDENCE. WHILE HE MAY ACCEPT THIS HINTELLECTUALLY XU'S REMARKS ARE LIKELY TO REINFORCE HIM HIN HIS VIEW THAT HIN THE LAST RESORT THE CHANESE WHILL NOT ALLOW THE HONG KONG ECONOMY TO RUN DOWN AND THAT THE RIGHT COURSE HS THEREFORE TO STAND FIRM.
