GIVEN PROMINENT COVERAGE IN TODAY'S INDEPENDENT AND ROUTINE COVERAGE IN THE LEFT-WING PRESS WERE AGENCY REPORTS OF THE PRIME HIMISTER'S COMMENTS ON A BBC WORLD SERVICE PHONE-IN PROGRAMME YESTERDAY. PARTICULAR ATTENTION WAS PAIND TO HER COMMENT THAT THE LAST ROUND OF SHNO-BRIDGISH TALKS ON HONG KONG "WERE VERY CONSTRUCTIVE AND WENT MUCH BETTER", AND TO HER BELIEF THAT "WE ARE REACHING A BETTER BASIS OF UNDERSTANDING OF WHAT INT INS THAT HAS MADE THUS REMARKABLE SUCCESS IN HONG KONG, AND HOW WE SHOULD ARRANGE FOR HIT TO CONTINUE". THERE WAS LISTTLE COMMENT ON THE AGENCY REPORTS.

2. WEN WEN PO (COMMUNIST) ON 30 OCTOBER QUOTED THE DIRECTOR OF THE CCP'S PROPAGANDA DEPARTMENT, DENG LIQUN, AS SAYING THAT THE LAST ROUND OF TALKS WAS ''BETTER'' THAN THE PREVIOUS ROUNDS. SPEAKING TO THE DIRECTOR OF A JAPANESE NEWS AGENCY, DENG SAND HE HOPED BOTH SIDES WOULD TRY HARD TO REACH A UNANIMOUS AGREEMENT. HE REINTERATED CHIMA'S HINTENTHON TO ANNOUNCE A UNHILATERAL DECISION HIN SEPTEMBER OF NEXT YEAR OF NO AGREEMENT ON HONG KONG'S FUTURE HAD BEEN REACHED BY THEN. HE DESCRIBED THE BASIC PRINCIPLE OF CHIMA'S FORMULA FOR HONG KONG AS ''ONE STATE, TWO SYSTEMS''.

3. BOTH THE HINDEPENDENT AND COMMUNIST PRESS GAVE PROMINENT COVERAGE TO, BUT MADE NO FURTHER COMMENT ON AGENCY REPORTS OF DENG XHAOPHNG'S COMMENTS TO THE SPANISH FOREIGN MINNISTER, MORAN. HIN PEKING ON SUNDAY. DENG HIS REPORTED TO HAVE SAND THAT

CUYERAGE TO, BUT HADE NO FUNTHER COMMENT OF DENG XMAGPHIC & COMMENTS TO THE SPANUSH FOREIGN MUNICIPED, MORAN, IN PEKING ON SUNDAY. DENG IS REPORTED TO HAVE SAID THAT THE QUESTION OF WHO WOULD ADMINISTER HONG KONG AFTER CHINA HAD REGAMMED SOVERENGNTY OVER THE TERRINTORY WAS NOT OPEN TO NEGOTIVATION . 4. WHITLST THERE HAS YET BEEN LATTLE COMMENT ON THE REMARKS ATTRHBUTED TO ENTHER DENG, AN EDITORHAL HIN THE FINANCHAL DAHLY (INDEPENDENT) TODAY ARGUED THAT DENG X-RAOPING AND DENG LHOUN'S REMARKS SHOWED THAT CHINA HAD "STUDIED THE NEW PROPOSALS" AND THAT THE SHIND-BRIGTHISH TALKS WERE MAKING GOOD PROGRESS. 5. BOTH THE INDEPENDENT AND COMMUNIST PRESS GAVE SOME PROMINENCE TO DR HENRY KASSANGER'S COMMENT (AN AN ADDRESS TO THE HONG KONG TRADE FAME SEMINAR) THAT THE U.S. SHOULD STEER CLEAR OF ANY MENVOLVEMENT HAN THE DISCUSSIONS OVER HONG KONG'S FUTURE. THIS WAS STRUCTLY A MATTER FOR THE CHANESE AND BRATASH GOVERNMENTS. HOWEVER, HE DHO EXPRESS HIS CONFIDENCE THAT A SOLUTION COULD BE FOUND. THE NEW EVENING POST (COMMUNIST) PLAYED UP KINSSHNGER'S REPORTED REMARK THAT CHIMA WAS NOT HIN THE HABRIT OF BREAKING HTS PROMISES.
