Von. 1 to there: [maybe "reply to there" – the Hungarian word meaning "pointing at something" is not clear]

For the FCO's earlier, expressed [meaning: "it was their underlined, separate request"] wish I already did the announcement for Birch in the evening of 3rd January by telephone. He received it with rather great happiness. He stated: he immediately informs the prime minister and their ambassador in Budapest. Before this, on the 3rd [January] at noon he had told me that Deputy Under-Secretary of State Bullard would accept me on the 6th at 16 o'clock to discuss questions in connection with the visit in the company of Birch. I suggest to urge also at the British ambassador the clearing up of detail-questions in connection with the visit.
