The Prime Minister has asked me to thank you very much for your letter of 18 January about your visit to Hungary as a representative of British Church Women.

As you say, the Foreign and Commonwealth Office have full reports of your work in Hungary and Poland. They have commented on the value they place on your visits and on developing relations between the Churches in Eastern Europe and in Britain. Sadly, the Prime Minister's visit to Hungary will be all too brief and there will not be time to visit Debrecen and to see the Church leaders there. But the Prime Minister understands that they are all well known to our Embassy in Budapest.

Mrs. Thatcher is most grateful to you for giving us this background to the Churches in Hungary, and for your good wishes for her visit.
