Computer addicts will soon have a chance to pit their wits against Mr Arthur Scargill, the miners' leader, in a computer game developed by a Sheffield software company and due to go on sale in September.

The company, Grenin Graphics, has written to Mr Scargill offering 5p for the National Union of Mineworkers welfare fund for every game.

The game features Monty the Mole who has to negotiate dangers in a pit village and coalmine to collect coal before entering King Arthur's castle.

The company commissioned a miner's son, Mr Peter Harrap, aged 19, of Stainforth, near Doncaster, to write a program for the game.
