YOUR TELNO 906: FUTURE OF HONG KONG

- 1. THANK YOU FOR THESE HELPFUL INSTRUCTIONS.
- 2. 1 MET WU THIS MORNING IN RESTRICTED SESSION. I DEPEATED THAT
  THE DIFFICULTIES OF THE LOCATION OF THE JOINT GROUP WEEF REAL.
  BUT I ATTACHED GREAT IMPORTANCE TO MAKING A BREAKTHROUSE, IF
  POSSIBLE ON ALL OUTSTANDING ISSUES, FURING MY CURRENT DISIT. OR.
  THAT BASIS WE WERE PREPARED IN PRINCIPLE TO APPROACH THE PROBLEM
  ON THE BASIS OF THE CHINESE PROPOSALS, PROVIDE THAT THE REQUIPEMENTS
  OF BOTH SIDES COULD BE MET. POINTS OF MAJOR DISEIGULTY WOULD NEED
  TO BE RESOLVED BEFORE AGREEMENT WOULD BE POSSIBLE.

- THE JOINT GROUP INDICATED THAT THE UNDERSTOOD TO ASIS FOR OUR ARGUMENTS. HONG YOUR NEEDED TIME TO DIGEST AN AND DICEMENT OF THE GROUP AND THE PROSPECT OF THE GROUP ITBELF. INC. DO PRESENTATION WERE EXTREMELY IMPORTANT. WE ACCESS THAT THEY WOULD NOT WISH TO WAIT UNTIL THE NEXT DECADE. WE BELIEVED THAT A DELAY OF FIVE YEARS FROM NOW UNTIL 1989 WOULD BE UNDERSTOOD.

  IT WAS ALSO ESSENTIAL TO PROMULGATE PUBLICLY THE VERY IMPORTANT STATEMENTS ON THE JOINT GROUP AND MAIN AGREEMENT WHICH WE HAD MADE YESTERDAY (PARAGRAPH 2(III) OF YOUR TELEGRAM).
  - 4. I REPEATED THAT WE WOULD WANT TO LOOK AT THE PACKAGE AS A MADELLE I THEREFORE PROPOSED THAT TWO WORKING GROUPS SHOULD BEGIN MEETING.

    AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO FINALISE THE MAIN OUTSTANDING POINT ON THE MAIN AGREEMENT AND OUR PAPER ON THE JOINT GROUP.
  - 5. I TOLD WU THAT I LOOKED FORWARD TO DISCUSSING THESE POINTS
    THIS AFTERNOON WITH PREMIER ZHAO ZIYANG, I WOULD THEN NEED TO
    CONSULT YOU AGAIN AND WOULD WELCOME A FURTHER MEETING WITH
    CHINESE LEADERS TOMORROW, I REAFFIRMED THAT OF COURSE WE WOULD NEED
    TO LOOK AT THE AGREEMENT AS A PACKAGE BEFORE DECIDING WHETHER WE
    COULD RECOMMEND IT TO PARLIAMENT.
  - 6. IN REPLY WU BEGAN BY ASKING WHETHER WE HAD PROPOSED THAT THE GROUP SHOULD START WORK IMMEDIATELY OR SHOULD START WORK IN 1080, I EXPLAINED THAT WE ENVISAGED THE GROUP STARTING WORK SOOM AFTER THE SIGNATURE OF THE AGREEMENT, MEETING PERIODICALLY IN LONBON, PEKING AND HONG KONG, AND MOVING TO LOCATION IN HONG KONG IN 1989.
- 7. WU THEN SAID THAT WE HAD CLEARLY SERIOUSLY CONSIDERED THEIR PROPOSALS, AND THEY HAD GIVEN SERIOUS CONSIDERATION TO THE PRESENTATION WHICH I MADE YESTERDAY. THEY ATTACHED GREAT IMPORTANCE TO LOCATION OF THE GROUP IN HONG KONG. THE PURPOSE OF THE GROUP WOULD SIMPLY BE TO HELP MAINTAIN STABILITY AND CONFIDENCE IN HOLE KONG. ESSENTIAL FACTORS FOR MAINTAINING STABILITY WERE:

  AN AGREEMENT SHOULD BE CONCLUDED BETWEEN BRITAIN AND CHINA ACCEPTABLE TO BOTH SIDES AND COMPRISING OF A MAIN AGREEMENT AND ANNEXES: AFTER THE SIGNATURE BOTH SIDES SHOULD FAITHFULLY ARISE BY IT: NEITHER CHINA NOR BRITAIN SHOULD TRY TO ACT INDEPENDENT.

- \*\* 8. WU SAID THAT, TAKING INTO ACCOUNT APPREHENSIONS EXPRESSED BY

  BRITAIN, THE CHINESE GOVERNMENT WAS NOW PREPARED TO SPEED UP

  PROMULSATION OF THE BASIC LAW TO A TIME BEFORE 1990.
  - 9. WE WENT ON TO SAY THAT, TAKING ACCOUNT OF THE POINTS PUT FORWARD IN MY PRESENTATION YESTERDAY, THE CHINESE GOVERNMENT HAD GIVEN FURTHER CONSIDERATION TO THE TIMING OF THE LOCATION OF THE GROUP IN HONG KONG. THEY REALISED THAT THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT'S ATTITUDE WAS SERIOUS AND SINCERÉ. THEY THEREFORE NOW PROPOSED THE LOCATION OF THE GROUP IN HONG KONG SHOULD BE DELAYED UNTIL 1988. HENCE THERE WAS ONLY THE DIFFERENCE ON ONE YEAR BETWEEN THE PROPOSALS OF THE TWO SIDES.
  - 10. ON THE TIMING OF THE WORK OF THE GROUP AFTER 1997, HE CONTINUED, THE CHINESE SIDE TOOK ACCOUNT OF THE FACT THAT THE YEAR 2000 WAS A BEGINNING OF A NEW ERA. THIS WAS WHY THEY DID NOT WANT THE GROUP TO CONTINUE AFTER THE YEAR 2000. THEY HOPED THAT THE BRITISH SIDE WOULD BE PREPARED TO LOOK AT THIS QUESTION AGAIN
  - 11. WU CONFIRMED THAT THE CHINESE SIDE WERE PREPARED TO AGREE TO PUBLICATION OF THE ASSURANCES GIVEN BY HIM YESTERDAY. THE MODALITIES WOULD NEED TO BE WORKED OUT. HE AGREED THAT THE TWO WORKING GROUPS SHOULD START WORK IMMEDIATELY TO DISCUSS THE MAIN OUTSTANDING POINTS ON THE MAIN AGREEMENT AND OUR PAPER ON THE JOINT GROUP.
  - 12. I SAID THAT WE WOULD REFLECT ON THE NEW CHINESE PROPOSAL.

    I LOOKED FORWARD TO SEEING PREMIER ZHAO THIS AFTERNOON AND WOULD REPORT TO YOU AFTERWARDS. I HOPED THAT I WOULD HAVE A CHANCE TO MEET OTHER CHINESE LEADERS TOMORROW WHEN I HAD BEEN ABLE TO COLLECT MY GOVERNMENT. WU SAID THAT IT WOULD BE MOST HELPFUL IF MY RESPONSE COULD BE READY IN TIME FOR THE MEETING WITH PREMIER ZHAO THIS AFTERNOON (0830Z). I EXPLAINED THAT YOU WOULD BE IN TED AND ENTITLED TO SLEEP BUT THAT WE SHOULD DO OUR BEST.

## COMMENT

13. IN FACT I BELIEVE THAT THE NEW CHINESE PROPOSAL FULLY MEETS
THE REQUIREMENTS SET OUT IN YOUR TELEGRAM. I SHOULD BE GRATIFUL
THEREFORE FOR YOUR AUTHORITY TO SETTLE ON THIS BASIS, IF AT ALL
POSSIBLE BY 0800Z TODAY. IF THIS IS NOT POSSIBLE BY THEN I CAN
OBVIOUSLY PLAY THE HAND WITH ZHAO THIS AFTERNOON IN THE MEANTIME.
BUT AGREEMENT ON THESE LINES IS LIKELY TO BE THE KEY TO A
MEETING WITH DENG TOMORROW WHICH WILL BE IMPORTANT FOR SUBSTANCE
AND PRESENTATION PURPOSES.

- 2. 1 MET WU THIS MORNING IN RESTRICTED SESSION. 1 REPEATED THAT THE DIFFICULTIES OF THE LOCATION OF THE JOINT GROUP WERE REAL.
  BUT I ATTACHED GREAT IMPORTANCE TO MAKING A BREAKTHROWN, IF POSSIBLE ON ALL OUTSTANDING ISSUES, FURING MY CURRENT 181T. ON THAT BASIS WE WERE PREPARED IN PRINCIPLE TO APPROACH THE PROBLEM ON THE BASIS OF THE CHINESE PROPOSALS, PROVIDE THAT THE REQUIREMENTS OF BOTH SIDES COULD BE MET. POINTS OF MAJOR DIFFICULTY WOULD NEED TO BE RESOLVED BEFORE AGREEMENT WOULD BE POSSIBLE.

THE FORT GROUP INDICATED THAT THEY UNDERSTOOD THE BASIS FOR OUR ARCUMENTS. HONG KONG NEEDED TIME TO DIGEST AN ANNOUNCEMENT OF THE GROUP AND THE PROSPECT OF THE GROUP ITSELF. MING AND PRESENTATION WERE EXTREMELY IMPORTANT. WE ACCEPTED THE GROUP THAT THEY WOULD NOT WISH TO WAIT UNTIL THE NEXT DECADE. WE BELIEVED THAT A DELAY OF FIVE YEARS FROM NOW UNTIL 1989 WOULD BE UNDERSTOOD. IT WAS ALSO ESSENTIAL TO PROMULGATE PUBLICLY THE VERY IMPORTANT STATEMENTS ON THE JOINT GROUP AND MAIN AGREEMENT WHICH WU HAD MADE YESTERDAY (PARAGRAPH 2(111) OF YOUR TELEGRAM).

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- 5. I TOLD WU THAT I LOOKED FORWARD TO DISCUSSING THESE POINTS THIS AFTERNOON WITH PREMIER ZHAO ZIYANG. I WOULD THEN NEED TO CONSULT YOU AGAIN AND WOULD WELCOME A FURTHER MEETING WITH CHINESE LEADERS TOMORROW. I REAFFIRMED THAT OF COURSE WE WOULD NEED TO LOOK AT THE AGREEMENT AS A PACKAGE BEFORE DECIDING WHETHER WE COULD RECOMMEND IT TO PARLIAMENT.
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  AFTER SIGNATURE. COOPERATION SHOULD BE INTENSIFIED.
