YOUR TELNO 906 : COAL HADUSTRY.

- 1. WE HAVE NO DETAILS OF RECENT OR PLANNED PART CLOSURES IN THE SOVIET UNION AND DISCREET ENQUIRMES WITH OTHER EMBASSIES HAVE NOT PRODUCED ANY RELEVANT INFORMATION.
- 2. YEFHMOV, A DEPUTY CHARF EDINTOR OF MIZVESTMA, TOLD MINNISTER ON 1 OCTOBER THAT THE SOVEET UNION FOLLOWS THE SAME POLICY AS THE UK: WHEN A POST HIS NO LONGER VINABLE, THE MINNERS CONCERNED ARE GIVEN MATERIAL MINCENTINES TO MOVE TO ALTERNATIVE AREAS. THE MOVE HIS PREPARED 'SEVERAL YEARS' MIN ADVANCE THROUGH DISCUSSMONS BETWEEN THE MANAGEMENT AND UNHON. THOUGH YEFMMOV WAS NOT SPECIFIC, HE GAVE THE MAPRESSMON THAT A POST DOES NOT HAVE TO BE COMPLETELY WORKED OUT BEFORE MIT HIS CLOSED.
- BE USED DIRECTLY , ON AN ATTRIBUTABLE BASHS. BUT WE WOULD SEE NO OBJECTION TO YOUR SAYING , HE INT. WERE THAT USEFUL, THAT WE BELIEVE THE SOVERT AUTHORISTIES FOLLOW BROADLY THE SAME POLICUES OF CLOSHING UNVINABLE MINES AND GRIVING THE MINERS CONCERNED MATERIAL INCENTIVES TO MOVE TO ALTERNATIVE AREAS.
- 4. A FURTHER POSSMBLE SOURCE OF INFORMATION WHICH YOU MAY LIKE TO PURSUE INS THE BREATHISH ELEMENT IN THE UK/USSR WORKING GROUP ON THE COAL INDUSTRY ; OF WHICH THE BREATHISH CO-CHAIRMAN INS MR PETER TREGELLES, DIRECTOR OF THE NCB MINNING RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT ESTABLISHMENT (MRDE).
