SA confirmed, through contact with the Foreign Dignitary Protective Division, that Prime Minister THATCHER was at Camp David on 11/14-15/86.
AUSA Middle District of Florida, Orlando, Florida, advised he would prosecute for a violation of Title 18, USC, Section 112, Protection of Foreign Officials, Official Guests, and Internationally Protected Persons. advised that venue to prosecute exists within the Middle District of Florida as the subject formulated his plan and initiated his attempt to commit the violent act against Prime Minister THATCHER from the Middle District of Florida.


Baltimore suggests that Tampa seriously consider the subject's mental status in this matter as he is suicidal. Besides trying to hang himself in the holding cell of the Maryland State Police Barracks in Frederick, Maryland in 11/86, he also indicated that the weapon he had with him would be used to draw fire from the police. This action is known as "suicide by cop" and is a well-known way of committing suicide by depressed individuals. Additionally, at no time during the incident in the state of Maryland did the subject ever indicate he was en route to Camp David and, in all actuality, thought he was in the state of Pennsylvania at the time of the arrest. He never mentioned the name of MARGARET THATCHER or RONALD REAGAN nor was he on a mission of violence.
