PRIME MINISTER

PARTY CONFERENCE: MOTION ON LOCAL GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

I have seen the Secretary of State for the Environment's paper C(84)28.

- I am rather concerned that his proposed amendment and what he proposes to say in responding to the debate will raise expectations of major change in the system of financing local government. I think this would be a mistake for very much the reasons which persuaded us against announcing a formal review. It is not clear that we will be able to devise and deliver a solution to the intractable problems of the rating system and it is important not to create a sense of uncertainty about our aims at the time that we are introducing rate capping and abolishing the metropolitan counties.
- I hope, therefore, that the Secretary of State will agree to modify the amendment, in particular to avoid the words "urges the Government to <u>make</u> improvements", and will be careful not to raise expectations of further reforms of the rating system when he responds to the debate.
- I am sending copies of this minute to other members of the Cabinet and to Sir Robert Armstrong.
