
Dear Keith,

Thank you for your letter of 17 October to Nigel Lawson about the draft response to the Gregson Report. I have also seen Leon Brittan's letter to Nigel of 23 October.

Nigel and I agree that it would be sensible and constructive to review the information currently available on tax reliefs for donations to educational institutions, and to assess the need for more comprehensive and easily assimilable guidelines.
