I write to express my appreciation for the opportunity to have discussions with you during my recent visit to London.

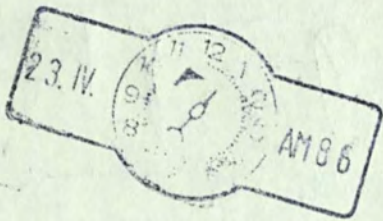
