3. THE ARGENTINES HAVE NOW PROVIDED US WITH THEIR LANGUAGE
ON DECOLONIZATION. AS PROMISED, WE ARE PROVIDING IT TO
HMG. BEGIN TEXT.

THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT SHALL ADOPT MEASURES NECESSARY TO
COMPLY, WITH RESPECT TO THE MALVINAS, SOUTH GEORGIA, AND
SOUTH SANDWICH ISLANDS, WITH RESOLUTION 1514 (XV) OF
THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE UNITED NATIONS, COMPLETING THE
DECOLONIZATION OF THE SAME BY 31 DECEMBER 1982, TAKING INTO
ACCOUNT THAT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH RESOLUTIONS 2065 (XX),
3160 (XKVIII), AND 31/49 OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY
OF THE UNITED STATES, IN THIS CASE THE PRINCIPLE OF
ARGENTINE TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY IS APPLICABLE.
