When the Foreign and Commonwealth
Secretary called on the Prime Minister today
he expressed the view that, on the assumption
that the debate on the Franks Report lasted
for two days, it would be wrong for the Prime
Minister not to be supported by Front Bench
spokesmen. He believed that a MOD Minister
should speak at the end of the first day and
that he himself should open on the second day.
Mr. Pym emphasised that he considered it
important that a FCO Minister should speak
during the debate.

The Prime Minister neither accepted nor rejected these ideas.
