SINCE BOUTROS IS PROBABLY BETTER INFORMED THAN ANY OTHER EGYPTIAN ABOUT THE PREPARATIONS FOR THE SUMMIT, YOU SHOULD KNOW THAT HE ADDED PRIVATELY THAT IN HIS VIEW THE UK WAS NOT DOING ENOUGH - WORLDWIDE - TO COUNTER THE ARGENTINE CAMPAIGN.
