

1. AS REPORTED IN OUR TUR, WE PUT TO THE AMERICANS AT THE END OF JANUARY THE PRIME MINISTER'S INVITATION TO MR REAGAN FOR DINNER ON 5 JUNE AND HER SUGGESTION OF BILATERAL TALKS. WE HAVE NOW HEARD INFORMALLY FROM THE EMBASSY THAT THEY DO NOT EXPECT TO LET US HAVE A REPLY BEFORE DEAVER'S RECCE VISIT IN MID-MARCH. NO 10 ARE KEEN TO FINALISE THE ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE PERIOD LEADING UP TO THE SUMMIT AND DELAY OF ANOTHER THREE WEEKS WOULD BE UNFORTUNATE. WHILST WE RECOGNISE THE DIFFICULTY OF ELICITING A RESPONSE FROM THE WHITE HOUSE WHEN THE PROGRAMME PLANNERS MUST BE SO HEAVILY ENGAGED IN THE RUN-UP TO THE VISIT TO CHINA, WE SHOULD BE GRATEFUL FOR ANY EARLIER INDICATION YOU CAN GAIN AS TO THE LIKELIHOOD OF THE PRESIDENT ACCEPTING OR DECLINING THE INVITATION.
