I TOOK THE OPPORTUNITY OF A PREVIOUSLY-SCHEDULED CALL ON P C ALEXANDER (MRS GANDHI'S PRINCIPAL SECRETARY) YESTERDAY EVENING TO DELIVER THE PRIME MINISTER'S RESPONSE TO MRS GANDHI'S LETTER OF 16 MAY. 2. I SAID I UNDERSTAND THAT JHA'S VISIT TO LONDON HAD GONE WELL. ALEXANDER HAD AGREED.
