Dear Prime Minister,

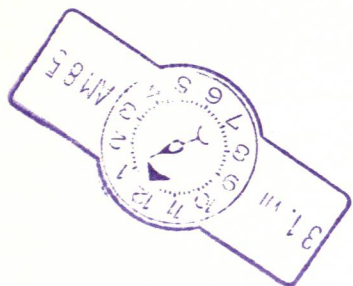
I wanted you to know how much I appreciated your including me at your lunch party on Sunday.
