1 Following our meeting earlier this evening, I propose to announce the additional support for Local Enterprise Agencies as part of the group of measures which I shall announce next week at the same time as we announce the abolition of redundancy rebates.

2 The necessary expenditure was agreed as part of my PES Survey baseline and there has been no dissent from colleagues to the proposals that were contained in my most recent minute to you. This reflected E(A)'s conclusions on this issue.

3 I am copying this minute to the Chancellor of the Exchequer, the Paymaster General here and the Chief Secretary.
