So far as ABI is concerned things have moved forward. The day after the Seminar I wrote to members directing their attention to the concern which had been expressed over incentives. I will monitor progress (which will be governed by commercial considerations) by sending a questionnaire to members around the middle of the year. I have arranged to let the Home Office know the outcome.

So far as the crime competition is concerned it is conceivable that the Home Office will prefer a different sort of initiative. Our concern, of course, is to do what is most useful in this "publicity" area.
