Message from the President To Prime Minister Thatcher
For Charles Powell
From John M. Poindexter

Dear Margaret:

Thank you very much for your understanding of the reasoning behind my decision to act against Qadhafi's policy and practice of terrorism. Your offer of cooperation is most heartening and reaffirms the fundamental strength of the special relationship between our two countries.

In your message of April 10, you spoke of the need for targets which we might strike to be demonstrably involved in the conduct and support of Libyan terrorist activities. To achieve our objectives, U.S. forces will strike targets that are (1) directly related to Qadhafi's terrorist activities, and (2) related to his support for terrorist activities through command and control functions and logistic support activities.

In order to defend our own forces, limited defense suppression missions must be undertaken as well.

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Let me assure you that we are not targetting civilians, economic facilities or regular Libyan military troop concentrations. Again, a principal criterion for all our strikes will be to ensure the least possible risk of collateral damage and minimize risk to our own personnel.

I am convinced that FB-111's and supporting aircraft operating from bases in the United Kingdom are essential to provide us with the safest means of achieving our objectives with lowest possible risk of collateral damage. This derives from the aircraft's advanced avionics and precision strike capabilities.

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT TO PRIME MINISTER THATCHER

APRIL 11. 1986

DEAR MARGARET:

THANK YOU VERY MUCH FOR YOUR UNDERSTANDING OF THE REASONING BEHIND MY DECISION TO ACT AGAINST QADHAFI'S POLICY AND PRACTICE OF TERRORISM. YOUR OFFER OF COOPERATION IS MOST HEARTENING AND REAFFIRMS THE FUNDAMENTAL STRENGTH OF THE SPECIAL RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN OUR TWO COUNTRIES.

IN YOUR MESSAGE OF APRIL 10, YOU SPOKE OF THE NEED FOR TARGETS WHICH WE MIGHT STRIKE TO BE DEMONSTRABLY INVOLVED IN THE CONDUCT AND SUPPORT OF LIBYAN TERRORIST ACTIVITIES. TO ACHIEVE

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OUR OBJECTIVES. U.S. FORCES WILL STRIKE TARGETS THAT ARE (1) DIRECTLY RELATED TO QADHAFI'S TERRORIST ACTIVITIES, AND (2) RELATED TO HIS SUPPORT FOR TERRORIST ACTIVITIES THROUGH COMMAND AND CONTROL FUNCTIONS AND LOGISTIC SUPPORT ACTIVITIES. IN ORDER TO DEFEND OUR OWN FORCES, LIMITED DEFENSE SUPPRESSION MISSIONS MUST BE UNDERTAKEN AS WELL.

LET ME ASSURE YOU THAT WE ARE NOT TARGETTING CIVILIANS. ECONOMIC FACILITIES OR REGULAR LIBYAN MILITARY TROOP CONCENTRATIONS. AGAIN. A PRINCIPAL CRITERION FOR ALL OUR STRIKES WILL BE TO ENSURE THE LEAST POSSIBLE RISK OF COLLATERAL DAMAGE AND MINIMIZE RISK TO OUR OWN PERSONNEL.

I AM CONVINCED THAT FB-111'S AND SUPPORTING AIRCRAFT OPERATING FROM BASES IN THE UNITED KINGDOM ARE ESSENTIAL TO PROVIDE US WITH THE SAFEST MEANS OF ACHIEVING OUR OBJECTIVES WITH LOWEST POSSIBLE RISK OF COLLATERAL DAMAGE. THIS DERIVES FROM THE AIRCRAFT'S ADVANCED AVIONICS AND PRECISION STRIKE CAPABILITIES.

I AM CONFIDENT THAT THE GUIDELINES WHICH I HAVE GIVEN MY MILITARY PLANNERS SATISFY YOUR CONCERNS REGARDING MY INTENTIONS.
