Tokyo Economic Summit

/ I enclose a copy of a letter from Prime Minister Nakasone to the Prime Minister about the forthcoming Tokyo Economic Summit. Mr Nakasone suggests that discussions at the Summit focus upon sustaining economic growth, improving the functioning of the international monetary system, strengthening free trade and assistance to developing countries. A copy of the "Main Issues for Discussion" paper, which was textually agreed by Personal Representatives at their meeting in Rambouillet on 18-20 April, is attached to the letter.
