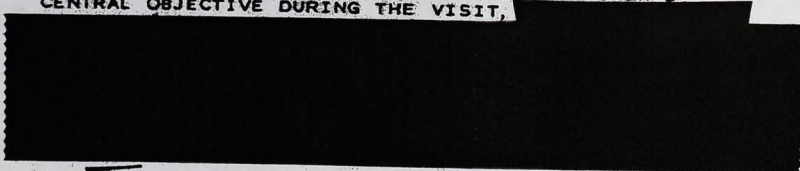

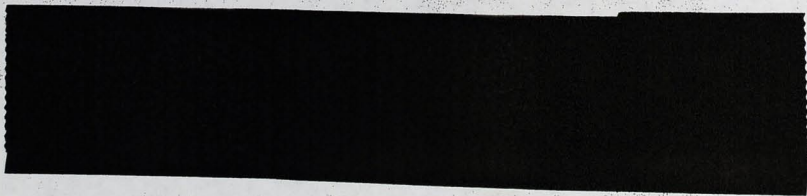

2. CHARGE MET ON NOVEMBER 4 WITH THE PRIME MINISTER'S PRIVATE SECRETARY, CHARLES POWELL. ASKED WHETHER MRS. THATCHER WOULD BE SEEKING A JOINT STATEMENT AT THE CONCLUSION OF HER FORTHCOMING CAMP DAVID MEETING WITH THE PRESIDENT. POWELL REPLIED THAT THE PRIME MINISTER HAD NO INTENTION OF DOING SO. ~~SHE, OF COURSE, WOULD HOLD AN END-OF-VISIT PRESS CONFERENCE BUT NO DRAFT COMMUNIQES WOULD BE UP HER SLEEVE ON ARRIVAL IN WASHINGTON. THE PRESIDENT AND PRIME MINISTER MIGHT AGREE THAT A JOINT STATEMENT WOULD BE DESIRABLE AT THE END OF THE TALKS, BUT THAT REMAINED TO BE SEEN.~~
