PRIME MINISTER AIDS H(A) met for the first time this afternoon. The main points agreed were as follows: There will be a major round of advertising in the Sunday newspapers starting on 23 November. This will be followed immediately by a poster campaign. In December the poster campaign will continue and will be aimed at young people. The issuing of a leaflet to every household was agreed. This will start as soon as possible, although it may be a month or so before the GPO can be geared up to handling it. Discussions are to take place with the BBC/IBA on a possible television campaign.
