REQUEST: Working visit (meeting and luncheon) by
Italian Prime Minister Spadolini

PURPOSE: To strengthen U.S.-Italian relationship
during a period when Italy has been
cooperating closely with and giving strong
support to U.S. on a wide range of issues;
to build support for the President in the
large Italian-American domestic constituency.

BACKGROUND: Giovanni Spadolini is the only one of the chiefs
of government of the five major U.S. allies who
has not been received for a visit in Washington
(the President received Italian President Pertini
for a State visit earlier this year). Spadolini
had not previously requested a visit due to
domestic problems, but after a recent reformation
of his government, has asked for a visit for
this fall.



SUBJECT: Italian Prime Minister's Request
to visit Washington

Following Spadolini's success in forming his second government, Italian Ambassador Pettrignani is energetically pursuing the idea of a working visit to the United States for Spadolini around October 8th. The Prime Minister has tentative plans to be in Rochester, N.Y. on that date to accept an honorary degree, but may well be able to adjust his schedule according to the President's availability.

We strongly recommend that the President extend an invitation to Spadolini in order to convey his personal recognition of Italy's difficult decision to participate in the Beirut Multinational Force. Moreover since he first became Prime Minister, Spadolini has stalwartly supported United States initiatives in foreign policy, most notably by holding firm to Italy's earlier decision to base cruise missiles in Sicily and by agreeing to participate in the Sinai MFO. The Spadolini Government, like other recent Italian Governments, has been among our most dependable allies. Indeed, in Ambassador Rabb's opinion, Spadolini II is the best Italian Government that we could hope to see at this time.

We therefore urge that the President invite Spadolini for a brief working visit to Washington in early October, as an expression of our appreciation for Italy's consistently strong support of United States foreign policy.
