Firstly, I would deny this altogether; perhaps the following form of words may be useful:

> "In the course of many years of research and writing about the extremist movements, Peter Shipley has been in touch with organisations on the far Left and the far Right. These contacts have been solely for the purpose of gathering information and purchasing literature which have formed the basis of his books and articles. He has never been a member of the National Front or any other extremist

organisation," -or a supporter left or right.
