SENIOR OFFICIALS MEETING 15 OCTOBER 1985

- I attended the Senior Officials' Meeting at 1430 hours
 Tuesday 15 October which considered the Commonwealth Secretary-General's proposals for the order of the Agenda.
- 2. The items discussed were:
 - a. Conference Arrangements
 - b. The Opening Session
 - c. Agenda
 - d. Timetable
 - e. Committee of the Whole and Communique
- 3. The Meeting endorsed the Secretary-General's proposals for:
 - a. Morning sessions 0930 1300

Afternoon sessions 1500 - 1800

with refreshment breaks of 15 - 20 minutes during the morning and afternoon sessions.

- b. Allocated seating arrangements for the opening ceremony (delegations to decide on attendance within their own allocation). Closed circuit TV viewing in the Cable Beach Hotel for those unable to be accommodated at the ceremony. Prime Ministers Mulroney, Gandhi, Mugabe, Mahathir and Hawke to reply to Sir Lynden Pindling's address of welcome.
- c. The Agenda to follow the pattern of the Commonwealth Senior Official's Annotated Agenda letter to Heads of Government dated 4 September 1985.
- d. Timetable as at Annex

- Committee of the Whole to commence work at 3 p.m. on e. Thursday 17 October to consider Agenda Items relating to functional co-operataion and reporting back to Heads of Government when they return from the Retreat to allow for discussions on Monday 21 October. Work on the Communique to commence on Friday afternoon 18 October with senior officials dividing into two groups to consider Political and Economic topics separately. Economic material to be updated by the Secretariat to take account of recent economic/finance meetings particularly the Commonwealth Finance Ministers' meeting in the Maldives.
- All these proposals were accepted by the senior officials without dissent. There was one intervention by the Malaysian represenative who sought an assurance that drug abuse would be discussed. The Commonwealth Secretary General confirmed that Heads of Government would be free within the parameters of the Annotated Agenda to raise any topic in the executive sessions including drugs and terrorism.
- Under other business, it was agreed that traditional arrangements would be followed when considering petitions:
 - to the Commonwealth Secretary-General a.
 - to collective Heads of Governments
 - to individual Heads of Governments C.
 - from multilateral bodies and d.
 - from what Mr. Ramphal described as the lunatic fringe.
- It had been decided that arrangements for the official photograph to be taken on stage at the opening ceremony would not be entirely satisfactory and some thought was now being given to a separate photograph at the end of the morning session on Thursday or Friday.
