THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT IS CONVINCED THAT ONE MUST STRIVE FOR METHODS OTHER THAN THE APPLICATION OF MILITARY FORCE IN THE SOLVING OF DIFFERENCES. EXPERIENCE HAS SHOWN THAT SUCH METHODS DO NOT LEAD TO SOLUTIONS OF PROBLEMS AND TO A RELAXATION (OF TENSIONS), BUT ONLY CREATE NEW TENSIONS AND DANGERS.

- WITHOUT PREJUDICE TO ITS CATEGORIC CONDEMNATION OF ANY TYPE OF TERRORISM, THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EXPECTS THE RETURN TO PEACEFUL MEANS FOR THE SETTLEMENT OF CONFLICTS, SINCE ONLY THEREBY CAN FURTHER USE OF FORCE BE AVOIDED.

POSTURE WAS INDUCED BY HIMSELF AND OTHERS BY POINTING OUT TO THE FM THAT THE U.S. CONGRESS AS WELL AS THE AMERICAN PEOPLE SUPPORTED THE PRESIDENT'S DECISION. THEY WERE ABLE TO CONVINCE THE FM THAT A LESS BALANCED STATEMENT WOULD INCUR UNNECESSARY POLITICAL COSTS. BUT AT THE SAME TIME, SUCHARIPA POINTED OUT THERE WAS DEEP AND GENUINE CONCERN THAT THE U.S. ACTION NOT LEAD TO AN ESCALATING CYCLE OF VIOLENCE. WHEN WE NOTED LONG-STANDING LIBYAN TERRORISM -- WHICH HAD GONE UNANSWERED, INCLUDING THE MOST RECENT TERRORIST ACTS, AND ASKED HOW THE AUSTRIANS WOULD HAVE RESPONDED, HE DEMURRED. AT THE SAME TIME, HE REPEATED THAT WHATEVER THE SOLUTION MIGHT BE, THE AUSTRIANS COULD NOT CONSIDER THE BOMBING OF LIBYA AS LEADING TO A DE-ESCALATION OF TERRORISM OR A CONTRIBUTION TO PEACEFUL RESOLUTION OF PROBLEMS.
