SUBJECT: REACTION IN SCOTLAND TO US ACTION AGAINST LIBYA.

1. AT THE CONSULATE:

AT NOON ON APRIL 15, 1986, APPROXIMATELY TEN DEMONSTRATORS GATHERED AT THE CONSULATEGENERAL TO DEMONSTRATE AGAINST THE U.S. STRIKE AGAINST LIBYA. IN THE EVENING THEY WERE JOINED BY SOME FIFTY OTHERS FOR A VIGIL WHICH LASTED UNTIL SHORTLY BEFORE MIDNIGHT. THE DEMONSTRATORS, WHO INCLUDED MEMBERS OF THE CAMPAIGN FOR NUCLEAR DISARMAMENT (CND), YOUNG COMMUNISTS, AND SEVERAL OTHER LEFTIST ORGANIZATIONS, CARRIED PLACARDS AND CHANTED SLOGANS. THERE WERE NO INCIDENTS, HOWEVER, AND POLICE PROTECTION WAS ADEQUATE.

2. MOREOVER, DURING THE PAST TWO DAYS THE CONSULATE GENERAL HAS RECEIVED NUMEROUS TELEPHONE CALLS BITTERLY CONDEMNING U.S. ACTION AGAINST LIBYA. THE POST HAS ALSO RECEIVED SOME 50-75 UNCLASSIFIED

THE SCOTTISH EDITION OF THE "DAILY UNCLASSIFIED RECORD", FOR EXAMPLE, FEATURED A FULL FRONT PAGE PICTURE OF A LIBYAN CHILD UNJURED IN THE RAID WITH THE HEADLINE QUOTE: "WE'D DO IT AGAIN" UNQUOTE. THE "GLASGOW EVENING TIMES" PROCLAIMED THAT THE BOMBING OF LIBYA WOULD DO NOTHING TO DIMINISH TERRORISM, THAT IT WAS INEXCUSABLE THAT INNOCENT VICTIMS WERE KILLED IN THE RAIDS, AND THAT THE PEOPLE OF BRITAIN WERE OVERWHELMINGLY AGAINST SUCH ACTION.

ON APRIL 16TH THE "GLASGOW HERALD" FEATURED A SKETCH OF PRESIDENT REAGAN WITH A SMOKING GUN AS A PREFACE TO ALL ARTICLES THEIR EDITORIAL ENTITLED QUOTE "MORE VIGILANTISM ABOUT LIBYA. THAN SELF-DEFESE" UNQUOTE NOTED THAT THE USG'S ARGUMENT THAT WE WERE EXERCISING AN INHERENT RIGHT OF SELF-DEFENSE UNDER AT BEST, IT CONTINUED THAT THE THE UN CHARTER WAS THREADBARE. RAID SPRINGS FROM CONSIDERATIONS HAVING LITTLE TO DO WITH ESSENTIAL STRATEGIC INTERESTS, AND WAS CARRIED OUT IN A WAY THAT MAXIMIZED THE MESSINESS OF THE ENTIRE OPERATION. THE OUTCOME, THE EDITORIAL CONTINUED, SEEMS MUCH MORE LIKELY TO INCREASE THAN TO REDUCE THE TERRORIST THREAT. IT CONCLUDED THAT PRESIDENT REAGAN HAS NEVER HAD A LARGE FAN CLUB IN THIS COUNTRY, BUT THIS PRACTICAL APPLICATION OF A CALAMITOUSLY SIMPLISTIC APPROACH TO INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS WAS BOUND TO INCREASE THE DISTRUST OF THE PRESIDENT ACROSS THE ENTIRE POLITICAL SPECTRUM AND PROMOTE UNCLASSIFIED

"THE SCOTSMAN" (EDINBURGH) PERHAPS SCOTLAND'S MOST PRESTIGIOUS NEWSPAPER, NOTED IN ITS EDITORIAL THAT THE DECISION TO BOMB LIBYA WAS AN EXTREMELY UNWISE RESORT TO MILITARY ACTION WHICH WILL ALMOST CERTAINLY BE INEFFECTIVE IN DEALING WITH THE PROBLEM OF MIDDLE EAST TERRORISM OR WITH COLONEL GADDAFI. FRUSTRATION IN WASHINGTON WAS UNDERSTANDABLE AT THE SUPPORT OF TERRORISM, BUT PRESIDENT REAGAN'S AGGRESSIVE RESPONSE WAS ILL-THOUGHT OUT AND WAS LIKELY TO BE COUNTER-PRODUCTIVE. RAID HAD BEEN CONFINED TO MILITARY TARGETS AND HAD NOT INVOLVED HEAVY CIVILIAN CASUALTIES, THERE MIGHT HAVE BEEN SOME JUSTIFICATION FOR THE ACTION, ALTHOUGH EVEN IN THOSE CIRCUMSTANCES IT WAS STILL ILL-ADVISED. THE ONLY SENSIBLE AND REALISTIC WAY TO DEAL WITH GADDAFI IS FOR THE US AND EUROPE TO ISOLATE LIBYA WITH WATER-TIGHT ECONOMIC SANCTIONS.
