- 2. BRITISH AMBASSADOR SNODGRASS PHONED AFTERNOON APRIL 18 TO TELL ME THAT HE HAD BEEN CALLED IN THAT MORNING BY CHIAE OF FOURTH DEPARTMENT PCHELINTSEV FOR A DEMARCHE ON THE LIBYAN SITUATION. PCHELINTSEV EXPRESSED GOB'S "CONCERN" ABOUT USE OF BRITISH BASES BY U.S. AIRCRAFT ENGAGED IN STRIKE AGAINST LIBYA. SNODGRASS SAID HE RESPONDED IN TOUGH TERMS AND ASKED PCHELINTSEV IF GOB HAD EXPRESSED CONCERN TO LIBYANS ABOUT THEIR SPONSORSHIP OF TERRORISTS ACTIONS.
