MISSING AMERICANS RELEASED

- 3. AT APPROXIMATELY 2300 HOURS LOCAL, JUNE 4, THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC SECURITY BELEASED TEN FOREIGNERS, INCLUDING THE TWO MISSING CBS EMPLOYEES AS WELL AS SEVERAL OTHER AMERICANS. THE GROUP MADE THEIR WAY TO THE FALACE HOTEL WHERE THEY COMPIRMED THEIR RELEASE.
- 4. AT APPROXIMATELY 2215 HOURS LOCAL, THE EMBASSY RECRIVED A CALL FROM THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC SECURITY (MPS) OFFICE WHICH HANDLES ALIEN AFFAIRS. THE MPS STATED THAT THEY HAD FOUR AMERICANS WHO MERE GOING TO BE RELEASED, INCLUDING TWO CES EMPLOYEES. DURING A FOLLOW-UP CONVERSATION MPS AGREED THAT AN EMBASSY VEHICLE COULD PICK UP THE ENTIRE GROUP OF FOREIGNERS, INSTEAD OF WAITING UNTIL THE MEET DAY.
