Dear Ron

Thank you for your message giving your decision to lift the sanctions imposed in December and June. This way I too am gratified that we have all been able to reach agreement on a more coherent approach to the handling of East/West economic relations, particularly at a moment when we must be seen to be standing together, as the Soviet leadership changes.

I agree with what you propose about the handling of your announcement. For my part I can agree that the summary of conclusions should be published for the reasons you give. /I had already asked our Ambassador in Paris to urge this course on the French.

As to the future, although as George Schultz knows we cannot be committed in advance to the outcome, I amprepared to instruct my officials to contribute whole-heartedly and expeditiously to a agreed programme of work.

I am grateful for what you said about the British contribution. For our part we have admired the role played by George Schultz and your senior officials in steering the negotiations to this conclusion.
