The Foreign and Commonwealth Secretary suggests, subject to the views of the Secretary of State for Trade, that Mr\_Rees would be the appropriate Minister. He speaks for us on a number of trade matters at General Councils and was intending to represent HMG at the Internal Market Council planned then cancelled by the Belgian Presidency.
