FRENCH ECONOMY: HEALTH OF THE FRANC SUMMARY

MITTERRAND'S XMAS STOCKING IS STUFFED A BIT TOO FULL OF LOANS. MORE AND MORE HIS CRITICS FORETELL AN EARLY BOUT OF INDIGESTION FOR THE FRANC. THEY FEAR THAT THE LARGE AMOUNTS OF BORROWED FOREIGN CURRENCY WHICH ARE BEING SPENT ON SUPPORTING THE FRANC AGAINST THE DEUTSCHMARK WILL BE WASTED BECAUSE DEVALUATION IS INEVITABLE. NOR ARE THERE ENOUGH SIGNS THAT MITTERRAND IS READY TO ADOPT A DEGREE OF RIGOUR THAT MIGHT STEM THE TIDE OF SPECULATION .. BUT HE MAY NOT BE ABLE TO POSTPONE THE DECISIVE MOMENT, AS HE HOPED, UNTIL AFTER THE MARCH MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS.

DETAIL

- 2. ON THE RETURN OF M DELORS FROM RIYADH, THE MINISTRY OF THE ECONOMY AND FINANCE HAS ALLOWED THE VEIL OF DISCRETION THAT HAS OBSCURED ITS NEGOTIATIONS FOR SAUDI FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (PARIS TELNO 1175 OF 11 DECEMBER) TO DROP JUST A FRACTION OF AN INCH. IT ISSUED A COMMUNIQUE YESTERDAY CONTAINING LANGUAGE THAT APPEARED TO CONFIRM (BUT ONLY IN THE MOST GENERAL TERMS) PRESS REPORTS OF AN AGREEMENT BY THE SAUDIS TO MAKE AVAILABLE TO FRANCE FUNDS OF THE ORDER OF 4 BILLION. IN TWO OPERATIONS OF 2 BILLION.
- 3. ASSUMING THE REPORTS ARE CORRECT, THIS BRINGS TO THE US 8 BILLION DOLLARS THE SUM WHICH, SINCE SEPTEMBER, FRANCE HAS ARRANGED TO BORROW, APPARENTLY FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING THE FRANC AGAINST THE DEUTSCHMARK IN THE EMS. UP TO US 3 BILLION APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN DRAWN ALREADY, ALTHOUGH PROBABLY NOT ALL OF THIS HAS BEEN SPENT. PUBLIC CRITICISM IS STARTING, ON THE GROUNDS THAT IF THE FRANC IS EVENTUALLY DEVALUED THE MONEY SPENT IN SUPPORTING IT WILL HAVE BOUGHT NOTHING OF LASTING VALUE. BT IS NOW ASSUMED BY ALL NON-GOVERNMENTAL EXPERTS WHOSE VIEWS ARE KNOWN TO US THAT THE FRANC WILL INDEED BE REALIGNED AGAINST THE DEUTSCHMARK IN 1983. AND SOME PEOPLE (INCLUDING, IN PRIVATE, THE FORMER PRIME MINISTER. RAYMOND BARRE) ARE SAYING THAT THIS WILL HAPPEN BEFORE THE MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS IN MARCH. 4. DELORS PROFESSES IN PUBLIC TO SEE NO NEED FOR ANY CHANGE OF PARITY NOW. NOR FOR ANY EARLY MOVE TO A MORE RIGOROUS ECONOMIC POLICY SUCH AS MIGHT STEM THE TIDE OF SPECULATION AGAINST THE CURRENCY BUT ADDS THAT

HE WILL NOT HESITATE TO RECOMMEND THAT THE SCREW MARKED RIGOUR BE GIVEN ANOTHER TWIST, IF IT BECOMES NECESSARY LATER. WHATEVER DELORS' REAL VIEWS ON THE MATTER, THERE IS CLEARLY NO

GOVERNMENT CONSENSUS FOR GREATER RIGOUR NOW . JEAN BOISSONAT, THE INFLUENTIAL EDITOR OF ''L'EXPANSION'' CAME AWAY FROM A RECENT INTERVIEW WIRH MITTERRAND CONVINCED THAT THE PRESIDENT HIMSELF WAS FAR FROM READY TO CHOOSE BETWEEEN THE ADVICE TENDERED BY THOSE LIKE DELORS WHO FAVOUR GREATER RIGOUR (''LES AUSTERES'') AND BY THOSE ('LES VOLUNTERRISTES'') LIKE CHEVENEMENT, THE MINISTER OF RESEARCH AND INDUSTRY, WHO, WITH EBULLIENT FAITH IN THEIR OWN POLICIES, BELIEVE THAT TOMOPROW'S GROWTH WILL PAY OFF TODAY'S DEBTS.

- 5. ACCORDING TO THE FORECASTS FOR FRANCE AND FOR THE WORLD ECONOMY IN 1983 JUST PUBLISHED BY OECD AND INSEE THAT TOMORROW IS NOT JUST AROUND THE CORNER. OVER THE NEXT SIX MONTHS, THE PURCHASING POWER OF HOUSEHOLDS IS EXPECTED TO DECLINE, INDUST -RIAL PRODUCTION MAY DECLINE ALSO, UNEMPLOYMENT IS LIKELY TO START RISING AGAIN, AND COMPANY FINANCES WILL DETERIORATE FURTHER. INFLATION WILL PROBABLY STAY ABOVE 9 PER CENT. A LOWER DOLLAR WILL CUT THE ENERGY IMPORT BILL BUT EXPORTS WILL GROW ONLY SLOWLY AND THE TRADE DEFICIT WILL IMPROVE ONLY GRADUALLY. IN PUBLIC, THE PRESIDENT AND DELORS MAKE GENERALISED BUT INSISTENT REFER -ENCES TO THE HELP THAT THE GERMANS OWE TO FRANCE IN ITS EFFORTS TO CUT ITS TRADE DEFICIT AND AVOID A THIRD DEVALUATION, BUT SCEPTICAL FRENCHMEN (AND EVEN THE GERMAN AMBASSADOR HERE) DOUBT GERMAN WILLINGNESS TO MAKE GREAT SACRIFICES TO SUPPORT THE GOV -ERNMENT WHICH IS NOT PREPARED TO CALL ON PEOPLE TO MAKE THE PAINFUL ADJUSTMENTS THEIR NEIGHBOURS ARE MAKING.
- 6. ON THE OCCASION OF THE 1981 AND 1982 DEVALUATIONS MITTERRAND ACTED TOO LITTLE AND TOO LATE. HIS RESOLVE TO BE A "FORCE TRANQUILLE ' SEEMED TO MAKE IT HARD FOR HIM TO READ THE SIGNS SOON ENOUGH. CONCERN TO GET PAST THE MARCH MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS MAY REINFORCE THIS TENDENCY. 1983 WILL SHOW WHETHER HE, AND HIS ADVISERS, HAVE LEARNT THEIR LESSONS OF EXPERIENCE. BUT THE EVIDENCE SO FAR IS NOT REASSURING.
