Thank you for your letter proposing to appoint _____ to the Parliamentary Boundary Commission for England. I regret to say that we do not know _____ and the information you have given us is not sufficient to make a proper judgement about his acceptability. I wonder if you know any more about him.

I am concerned that, if _____ were appointed, all three members would then be from the South of England, indeed almost from London itself. I believe there would be a better balance and greater confidence in the Commission if at least one of the Commissioners was from another part of the country. The appointment of a new Commissioner provides a fine opportunity to achieve this and I should be very glad if you would consider doing so.
