STATEMENT ON THE DEFENCE ESTIMATES

Thank you for copying to me your letter of 13 March.

I have no points to make on the text itself, but I believe that a clear re-affirmation of our Trident policy is very necessary. I hope that in briefing and speaking notes prepared for the Defence Estimates this can be underlined.

There is a clear feeling abroad, both in the House of Commons and outside in the country, that Trident is an optional extra. I am anxious to counter the growing argument which proposes that Trident becomes unnecessary if we go into Star Wars.

I am copying this letter to Cabinet Colleagues, and to Sir Robert Armstrong.
