1. WE WERE FINALLY ABLE TO SPEAK TO FONTANA GUSTINON 17 JUNE: RUGGIERO CANNOT SEE ME UNTIL 19 JUNE WHEN II WILL GO OVER THE GROUND FOR MILAN.

- 2. FONTANA GIUSTI SAID THAT THE PRESIDENCY WAS NOW REFLECTING ON WHAT HAD BEEN SAID AT STRESA IN ORDER TO DRAW UP TENTATIVE DRAFT CONCLUSIONS ON INSTITUTIONAL MATTERS AT MILAN. HE CONFIRMED THAT ANDREOTT !! SAW ATTRACTION IN THE IDEA OF TURNING THE LUX-EMBOURG EUROPEAN COUNCIL HATO AN HATER-GOVERNMENTAL CONFERENCE. AND HE HAD SAID AS MUCH AT A CHRISTIAN DEMOCRAT FOREIGN AFFAIRS SEMINAR IN FLORENCE OVER THE WEEKEND ATTENDED BY A MEMBER OF MY STAFF. BUT HT WOULD BE NECESSARY TO GIVE THE BUILD-UP TO THAT MEETING AS MUCH SHAPE AS POSSIBLE IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE THE POLITICAL IMPACT WHICH WAS NOW EXPECTED. HENCE THE ITALIAN SUGGESTION THAT FOREIGN MINISTERS SHOULD BE CHARGED WITH PREP-ARATION FOR HIT, AFTER MILAN, REMITTING WORK TO SENIOR OFFICIALS AS NECESSARY. WHO WOULD REPORT BACK TO FOREIGN MINISTERS BEFORE THE LATTER PRESENTED THE FRUITS OF THEIR WORK TO THE CONFERENCE/ EUROPEAN COUNCIL IN EARLY DECEMBER. WHETHER THIS WOULD RUN WOULD DEPEND ON THE ATTITUDE OF THE OTHER MEMBERS STATES. THE PRESI-DENCY NOW AWAITS A MEMORANDUM FROM THE FRENCH PROMISED AT THE FRANCO/HTALHAN SUMMIT LAST WEEK (REPORTED SEPARATELY).
- 3. AS TO OTHER ISSUES FOR MILAN, THE HITALIANS LIKED OUR DRAFT ON POLITICAL COOPERATION, BUT THOUGHT THAT IN CERTAIN RESPECTS IT COULD GO FURTHER, EG ON JOINT ACTION IN THIRD COUNTRIES. ANDREOTTI SAID IN FLORENCE THAT HE DID NOT DISAGREE WITH HTS INSTITUTIONALISTION PROVIDED THAT THIS DID NOT MAKE IT LESS EFFICIENT. FONTANA GIUST

HAD NOTHING NEW TO SAY ON DECISION MAKING OR THE POWERS OF THE PARLIAMENT.
