EUROPEAN COUNCIL IN MILAN: BILATERAL WITH SIGNOR CRAXI

Signor Craxi's office have been in touch with me several times in the last few days to try to arrange a time for a bilateral with the Prime Minister before the Milan European Council. In the event Signor Craxi decided for domestic political reasons he could not travel to London between now and the European Council. It has therefore been agreed that the bilateral will take place in Milan immediately before the beginning of the European Council itself. To allow reasonable time for this, the Prime Minister has agreed to travel to Milan on the evening of Thursday 27 June. Because of her commitments here, she will not be able to leave Heathrow earlier than 2100 hours. This will get us fairly late to Milan which will be inconvenient for the Italian authorities: but it is all to be helpful to them. I should be grateful if the necessary
