ARMS CONTROL: SOVIET VIOLATIONS

## ANNEX A

We received a detailed briefing from the United States
Secretary of Defence on the evidence of Soviet treaty
violations. We take the most serious view of this and call on
the new Soviet leadership to take the steps necessary to assure
full compliance with its commitments. We noted in this
connection that a double standard of compliance of arms control
agreement would be unacceptable and would undermine the security
of the Alliance. In this context, we reaffirmed the requirement
for effective verification of all arms control treaties.
